BOSTON CLASSIC CAR CLUB

CONSTITUTION

1. Club Title

The Club shall be known as the Boston Classic Car Club and the acronym, BCCC, may be used when appropriate.

2. Aims

The aims of the Club shall be:

- a. To encourage the enjoyment and preservation of classic and historic motor vehicles,
- b. To facilitate the sharing of technical information and the provision/exchange of spare parts as and when available,
- c. To provide the opportunity for members to meet socially at Club nights and other organised events.

3. Committee

The Committee shall comprise twelve Officers namely; Chairman, Vice-Chairman, Secretary, Treasurer, Membership Secretary, Social and Events Secretary, Show Secretary, Health and Safety Officer, Public Relations

Officer, Newsletter Editor, Regalia Officer, Website Controller plus a maximum of six other members.

Officers shall be elected at an Annual General Meeting (AGM) for a term of three years with one third being elected each year on a rota basis.

Other Committee members shall also be elected annually at the AGM. Retiring Committee Officers and other Committee members shall be eligible for reelection.

Club members may seek election to the Committee provided they have been members of the Club for at least one year.

The Committee shall have the power to co-opt any member to the Committee, should a vacancy arise, even if the co-opted member has been a member of the Club for less than one year.

Committee meetings shall be held monthly and must comprise a minimum of half the full membership of the Committee.

Any Committee member missing three consecutive meetings without a valid reason shall be assumed to have relinquished their Committee appointment.
