

The Chairman of any meeting shall have the casting vote in the case of equally split voting.

7. Conditions of Club Membership

Membership details will be retained on computer by the Membership Secretary who is the designated BCCC Data Protection holder.

Recorded information will only be used for the transmission of information relevant to the BCCC. Any Member objecting to this should write to the Club Secretary. Any Member bringing the Boston Classic Car Club into disrepute will, at the discretion of the Committee, have their membership terminated, or revoked without refund. The Boston Classic Car Club name should not be used in any discussion relating to the valuation of vehicles.

The Boston Classic Car Club name should not be used to further the business interests of any member.

A request for Club Membership may be refused at any time and with no reasons given, following a Committee discussion and decision.

Vehicles displayed on a Club stand, or at a Club show, must be at least 15 years old.

8. Annual General Meeting

When possible Annual General Meetings shall be held on the third Tuesday in November at which the Chairman will give an annual Club report and the financial accounts for the Club will be presented for approval.

Members wishing to discuss any other matters at the AGM should inform the Secretary, in writing, within a reasonable time prior to the meeting.

9. Extraordinary General Meeting

An Extraordinary General Meeting may only be called by the Club Secretary under the following circumstances:

- a. On receipt of a written request supported by at least 2/3 of the membership
- b. At the request of the Committee

Members will be given a minimum notice of 30 days of any Extraordinary General Meeting.

10. Charity
